

BC Mountain Trail Classes 2022

1. **Green in Hand**
First year showing Mountain Trail for horse or handler. Handler may have shown one weekend (2 shows) in the previous year
2. **Back to Basics**
More basic course, open to green & novice horses. No cross entries with Amateur +/- Open Rider Classes
3. **Green Horse**
Any horse, any age that has not been shown in Mountain Trail. Horses 6 and under may show in green classes for 2 seasons.
4. **Green Rider**
Any age, never to have shown in Mountain Trail, or Arena Trail at a sanctioned show. May not cross enter with Amateur +/- Open Classes. Contact show producer for eligibility if required.
5. **Explorer Horse**
Never having won a first in Mountain Trail, excluding in-hand classes. Using same map as Back to Basics, but extra obstacles may be added. with higher level of difficulty.
6. **Mares in Hand**
Any age, any breed, shown in halter or bridle.
7. **Geldings in Hand**
Any age, any breed, shown in halter or bridle
8. **Novice Horse**
Never having won 5 firsts in Mountain Trail Novice Horse Division. See eligibility list on results page.
9. **Novice Rider**
Never having won 5 firsts in Mountain Trail, Novice Rider Division. See eligibility list on results page.
10. **Open Handler**
More technical in hand over obstacles, same course as Open and Amateur Class
11. **Open**
More advanced course, more technical obstacles, open to all riders. No cross entries with Green Classes
12. **Open Novice Horse**
Horse not to have won a first place in the Open Class. This is an opportunity for Open riders to show a Novice Horse and for Novice Riders to prepare for Open Classes.
13. **Amateur Rider**
Open Obstacles. Does not receive money as a coach, trainer or similar profession in the Equine industry.
14. **Novelty Class**
To be announced for each show.
